

Notes of BACF meeting held on 10th February 2017

School Library

The possibility for a grant from the Foyle Foundation for upgrading and updating the existing school library was presented by me. Ms. Matthews put forward the idea of SEN Centre cum library. This was thought to be a possible longer term plan by those present.

Decision – To proceed with the grant application

- To include as counterpart contribution £1000 from BACF funds, £1000 from the Scholastic funds for books from Scholastic, and a parent's offer to donate a carpet for the library

Action – Nicki to contact Sam (full name??) to arrange a meeting to discuss the business and admin details of the application. Meeting has subsequently been set of Thursday 16th Feb at 2 pm.

- After this meeting. For BACF to meet with Mrs. Foster and Salam (as the people in charge of the library) to brainstorm ideas for upgrading, ie- work out budget items.

Premises Licence for the sale of alcohol

Not sure if the Governors had responded to our request. I spoke to the Licensing Authority at the Rochdale Council and found out that the application process would be at least 28 days long. The application fee depends on the non-domestic value of the premises (business rates).

Action – Find out from Sam what the value of the premises is in order to determine if such an application is financially worthwhile.

In the meantime, BACF will work on Temporary Events Notices (TENs).

Action – Ask Sam if the BACF bank account details could be used to pay TEN fees instead of personal accounts as debit card details have to be divulged in order to do this.
