Through Philosophy for Children lessons, we develop children to think critically, creatively and caringly and to question and reason.

Our school encourages children to explore different cultures and religions across the world and promote an understanding and appreciation for diversity: this has been recognized through our International Schools Award.

We also protect children from the risk of radicalization, for example by using filters on the internet, or by vetting visitors who come into the school to work with pupils.



## How does Prevent relate to British Values?

Schools have been required to promote British values since 2014.

Through our curriculum we teach children about the British values of:

- Democracy
- The rule of law
- Individual liberty and mutual respect
- Tolerance of different faiths and beliefs
